The Department of Rehabilitation (DOR) administers the largest vocational rehabilitation and independent living programs in the country.

What is independent living?

Independent Living (IL) is both a cultural movement and a program. It is a way of looking at disability that puts the individual first and the disability second. The IL community works toward equal opportunity for people with disabilities to share in all the benefits of society.

What is an independent living center?

An independent living center serves people with disabilities in a local community who can benefit from services. Independent living centers are designed and operated by people with disabilities.
